

ENGAGING DIALOGUE, FOSTERING COLLABORATION AT THE CO CREATION LABS

With new types of threats and crimes developing every day, police not only have to face increasingly challenging operational demands, they also need to meet citizens' higher expectations for safety and trust. Public safety and security can no longer be the exclusive mission of law enforcement: the fight against crime and the creation of a safer world has become a shared responsibility for all stakeholders. The wider security community must therefore be included in the discussion and decision making process in order to fight the crimes of today, tomorrow and the future more effectively.

1. Global Safety Today

Cyber, Internet and Related Technologies

Encryption and anonymizing techniques are increasingly ubiquitous, threatening to hinder otherwise straightforward police investigations and operations. How will we detect, prevent, disrupt and enforce online security on both the traditional Internet and the Darknet?

Information has become the most valued form of currency. How can law enforcement and the private sector work together to detect and stop increasingly common data breaches?

Global cyberattacks in the style of WannaCry and Petya have the potential to disrupt everyday business with serious consequences. What options, mechanisms and possible solutions are available to fight them?

Smart Systems

Despite technological advances, the most valued source of information continues to be the public. Technology will nevertheless play a role by providing the necessary communication channels between police and the community through social media and apps. Smart Cities can become an information hub in which citizens can assist law enforcement through information and evidence collection. What are the expectations of our communities in ensuring public safety in the emerging Smart City?

While some fear a scarcity of reliable data through the increasing application of encryption, others fear a tsunami of information. What protections and safeguards are required to ensure information is available in a timely manner?

Criminals and terrorists are increasingly making use of drones to commit different crimes, from delivering bombs to swarm attacks. What anti drone solutions are available?



2. Improving Security for Tomorrow

Information Processing and Data Analytics

Businesses collect unprecedented levels of data from different sources to improve their services and increase their revenue. Big Data also provides opportunities for law enforcement to leverage information and data analytics in the fight against crime. However, this increasing access to information is perceived by many as a privacy intrusion. Is Big Data the next policing panacea or the Big Brother that George Orwell feared?

How can artificial intelligence and data analytics help us make sense of massive amounts of information and evidence? How can it be used to prevent crime?

Social Media Analysis

Social media analysis (SMA) is the science of extracting valuable insights from vast amounts of social media data to enable informed decision making. How can we leverage SMA to improve security and public safety?

Command, Control, Communication and Information

How can Command and Control Platforms help us have a holistic view of the city in relation to Smart Cities technology?



3. Forecasting and Planning for the Future

Emerging and Other Technologies

We need to prepare for technologies that will disrupt our current policies and systems. For example, how could 4D printing affect border and customs enforcement?

Identification Technologies

Technologies such as facial recognition help to locate and identify criminals, but have also sparked ethics and privacy concerns. How can law enforcement continue to chase criminals while preserving the public's trust?


